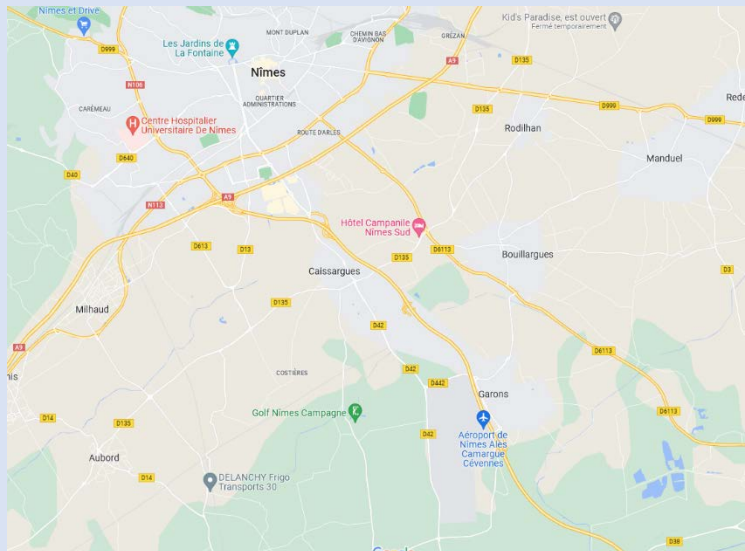

#### Location and access map

The FIRE-IN conference venue, Aéroport de Nîmes Alès Camargue Cévennes, is located at about 25 min by car from the city center of Nîmes.
